Information

The Autonomous Oblast of Nagorno-Karabakh became the center of a territorial dispute and of the struggle by its Armenian population for self-determination and independence from Azerbaijan.

From 1994 until the wars of 2016 and 2020, the Republic of Artsakh remained relatively stable. Following Azerbaijan's military offensives, culminating in the 2023 takeover of the region, the Armenian population was displaced and became refugees.

This map shows the active Armenian-inhabited villages, towns, and cities as of 2015, located within the former Nagorno-Karabakh Autonomous Oblast and the seven surrounding districts under the control of the Republic of Artsakh. Ruined, abandoned, and uninhabited settlements are not included.

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
